With further reference to your letter of the 15th February last, I have to advise you that on receipt of the plan and prints accompanying your letter of the 25th May, the local Indian Agent was asked for a report on the proposed road through Kopchitchin Indian reserve No.2 of the Boston Bar band.

The Agent now informs the Department that the roadway, according to the prints submitted, does not conform with the road as it exists at present and that the proposed road as shown on this plan would involve several acres of cultivated land, twelve full bearing fruit trees, a portion of a church and a portion of a dwelling house. The Agent, who was accompanied by the General Road Foreman, could not find any survey stakes on the proposed location. After his investigation, he discussed this matter with your Assistant District Engineer, Mr. Gallaher, who agreed that the plan is not in accordance with the existing road and stated he had communicated with your Department requesting that the application for getting this road be withdrawn.

I shall be pleased to hear what action your Department proposes to take in connection with the cancellation of the getting of this road.
