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Q.12 How is authority granted for the taking of such photographs?
A.12 From the Security Officer.

Judge Advocate: How did you satisfy yourself that these were improper?
Witness: There were no applications for permits.

Defending Officer: Where any such permission is granted does it always come to you?

Witness: I would say almost always.

Defending Officer: Who grants the permission or approval?

Witness: The Naval Officer in charge.

Defending Officer: Not you?

Witness: No.

Q.13 Do you know a person by the name of Mr. Cox of Brighton and he is employed by what firm?
A.13 Taylors.

Q.14 What do they do?
A.14 Developing and Printing.

Q.15 Do you know Mr. Walter John Simmons?
A.15 I know of him.

Q.16 Do you know where he is employed?
A.16 At Worthing.

Q.17 By whom?
A.17 Boots, Chemist.

Q.18 Can you tell the Court whether or not Mr. Cox or Mr. Simmons are persons authorized to receive such photographs under the Official Secrets Act.

Defending Officer: I object to that, he is not qualified to say whether they are or not.

Prosecutor: I would say that he has qualifications.

Defending Officer: Do you know who are or who are not qualified?

Prosecutor: He says he does not know.

Q.19 You examined these photographs, Exhibits "G"1 to "G"15 and what have you got to say as to the nature of the objects which have been photographed?
A.19 Military objects.

Q.20 Do you know whether or not they contravened any regulations?

Judge Advocate: As Security Control Officer are you familiar with Security Regulations.

Witness: Yes, sir, with Security Regulations.

Judge Advocate: In the course of your employment as Security Control Officer is it part of your duty to inspect photographs and make decisions on whether or not they contravene Security measures?

Witness: No, sir.

Judge Advocate: Therefore, you are not qualified.

Q.21 You told the Court that you were Security Control Officer for Newhaven and Shoreham.

A.21 Yes.

Q.22 Can you tell the Court anything of the Newhaven area?
A.22 It is a protected place, under the Defence Regulations.
