## Re: Permit. Squawkum Creek I.R. \#3

In reference to your letter of even rile dated 1st Novenber, 1954, e oncerning the proposed issue of a Permit to Donald Felix Joe, of the Ghehalis Band, to occupy the clarence hilisms honse on Squawicun Creek l.k. No. IS, we advise ks follows:

The honse, which was built from Band Funds of the Soowlitz Hend, is situate on a 2 acre portion of squawkum Creek I.R. No. \& vihich wes loceted to Clarence williams by Band Council Fiesolution dated April 19, 1949. This particular resolution was approved by the Depertment on May 30,1949 , in their letter, file No. 15153-6 (R.5).

The description of the property wes given as "approximately \& acres opposite J. Hardy Property on Highway".

In arder to get an eccurate description of the property, I contacted the Provincial Department of Public Works, who recently o ompleted a new survey of the Lougheed Highway, and obtained the following description:
"Commencing at a point on the North Boundary of Lougheed Highway on Squawkum Creek I.R. No. 3, said point being 618.92 feet north-easterly from a monument established adjacent to Squawkum Creek on the west; thence N. $14^{\circ} 24^{\circ}$ $45^{\prime \prime}$ W. 20 feet; thence $N .75^{\circ} 35^{\prime} 15^{\prime \prime}$ E. 200 feet along the north houndary of the Highway, thus establishing the S.W. corner of the property, thence $N$. 400 feet; thence E. 200 feet, thence S. 350 feet to the Highway; thence S. $75^{\circ} 35^{\circ} 15^{\prime \prime}$ W. 200 feet to point of commencement, and containing therein 2 acres, more or legs."
