Sir;-

I have the honour to inform you as follows in regard to your letter of January 27th.last,enclosing refund of permit fees in connection with prospecting applications on the Quesnel and Alexandria Indian Reserves.

Your letter states that the \$5.00 fee of F.A.Patrick is being held pending the receipt of his formal application for an Oil & Gas permit to prospect on Quesnel Indian Reserves.

On November 29th.1930 I wrote you and requested that surrender forms be sent to me in order that I could obtain the necessary surrender of the Quesnel Band. I have been holding the application of Mr Patrick in the meantime. These forms have not yet been received and I would ask that they be sent so that I can get the Quesnel Band together for the surrender.
