The upper part of the shield shows two fleur-de-lis of old France on a golden field; the second the lion of the English Coat of Arms the lower part a spray of three maple leaves. The History of Quebec is well told on this Coat of Arms, founded and nurtured by the French, developed by the English, it is now Canadian but remembers whence it sprung. Motto: "Je me souviens" (I remember.)
