Some of the churches that have had loans made to them seem to think that they can take their own time in repayment of them—even the small interest charged being often in arrears. We hope the minister who understands the principle and work of the Society will endeavor to point out the injustice of this to other churches needing help. Hoping for a better day and more fields for the Church Edifice Society,
