DR. BARNARDO'S HOMES.

The managers of these institutions invite applications from farmers and others for the boys and youths who are being sent out periodically from their English training-homes. The older boys remain for a period of one year at the Farm Heme at Russel, during which time they receive practical instruction in general farm work before being placed in situations.
