T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the seventeenth day of December, Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety-"two, in the thirty-third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE " the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of Great Britain, France and Ireland KING, " Defender of the Faith, &c.

" And from thence continued by several Prorogations to the twentieth day " of November, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, being the fourth " Session of the first Provincial Parliament of LOWER-CANADA."

### CAP. I.

AN ACT to declare and ascertain the Period when the Acts of the Provincial Parliament of this Province shall take effect.

#### (30th January, 1796.)

Preamble.
