VELOCITARY FIRE CATASTROPHE.

Congregation Causes Loss of Over 200 Lives.

PROBABLY MANY DROWNED

Will the Sunken Saale Prove a Grave? Channel House?—Fears That She Carries Many Dead—The Bremen Beached—The Money Loss is Great—C. E. Visitors Missing.

New York, July 1.—A great fire swept the docks of the North German Lloyd Company in Hoboken last night, and the loss of life and property caused was appalling. The total of the death list is not yet accurately known, but it is up in the hundreds.

200 Perished. New York, July 1.—The North German Lloyd Steamship Company estimates the loss of life by yesterday's fire at 200. The company took the crew lists, checked by those members who are in hospitals or reported safe and believes the others to be lost.
