

### Guilty or Not Guilty?

TWILIGHT SLEEP AS AN AID TO

The fact that when under the influence of anaesthetics patients sometimes talk, though unconscious, may lead to the most amazing step for many years in the administration of

justice. Anaesthetists and legal authorities are closely watching certain experiments that have been and are being made in order to test whether it is possible to make criminals tell the truth by the action of drugs and to use as evidence the words of innocent though accused persons who have no other way of clearing themselves from grave charges.

Without Will Power

The technique and procedure involved are briefly as follows: Most people have now heard of "twilight sleep," the condition induced by the administration of the drugs scopolamine and morphia. When these anaesthetics are administered by injection the effect follows in gradual stages. The patient loses the power of the senses, hearing, sight, touch, smell. The will also can no longer function. But the centres in the brain which control the power of speech

are not affected. Sense of hearing goes first, but as the effect of the drug begins to wear off this sense is the first to be recovered. If, therefore, the stages at which this happens can be artificially controlled and prolonged, it means that the individual under the anaesthetic can hear and speak, can be asked and can answer questions, though totally unable to control the

replies by will. The giving of answers to questions is controlled by the will. In a normal condition a man may choose whether he will tell the truth or lie in reply to what he is asked. Under the effect of drugs such as those mentioned, however, he is totally unable to control his replies, though

his memory can reply for him. At a recent meeting of the Eastern Society of Anaesthetists of the United States one of the members of the society, Dr. R. E. House, gave a report on his use of what is technically called scopolamin-apomorphia ampesia in criminology. He vindicated his method as a humane and scientific alternative to the brutality of the "third degree," and then proceeded to give the results of his test, which included two acquittals of boys accused of grave crimes, who could not in any other way have proved their

nnocence. "Notwithstanding what might be said to the contrary," said Dr. House, "I wish emphatically to state that with clinical doses there is no harm in the use of scopolamine. There are no dangerous after-effects. . . . When this technique of criminal analysis is clearly understood, the tech prove the guilt or innocence of a sus,

pected criminal." A boy had been imprisoned for highway robbery with firearms because he could not prove his innocence at his trial. In Dallas County Jail Dr. House called for volunteers for an experiment from among those who maintained their innocence. This

boy volunteered. At his examination under the drug the local district attorney was present. The boy's story was absolutely corroborated by other facts in the district attorney's possession, which had till then not been suspected of having any bearing on the case. The boy was released.

Leading authorities in this country who have been consulted in the matter consider that Dr. House's claim as to the action of the drug can well be taken seriously. While it is doubtful whether in every case the results would be as clear as he claims, it may well be that in due course the method will receive experimental trial.
