FINANCIAL AND COMMERCIAL

THE LOCAL MARKET

Although the supply of hay on the local market was large today, the highest price paid was \$15.50 per ton, an advance over any prices obtained during the week. Straw sells at a steady price.

Oats also sold at a former price, ranging from \$1.30 to \$1.40 per cwt. Wheat is slightly cheaper, the large market having declined. The price paid is \$1.35 to \$1.40 per bushel. Butter and eggs are steady. The supply on the market is just sufficient to meet the demand.

A larger market in butter is expected on Saturday, although cheaper prices are unlikely.

Live and dressed hogs are unchanged in price. Beef sells as high as \$12.50 and \$13 per cwt. The price is unsteady at present, ranging from \$11 to \$13. Veal sells at from \$9 to \$12 per cwt.
