The Ambassador of the United States of America presents his compliments to the Acting Secretary of State for External Affairs and has the honor to refer to recent discussions in the Permanent Joint Board on Defense and elsewhere concerning the proposed augmentation of communication facilities at DeW LAMP Island to support the Canadian Extension of the DEW Line (DEW LAMP). Details concerning the construction and equipment required for this augmentation have been supplied to the appropriate Canadian authorities and the United States Government now proposes that the establishment and operation of these facilities be authorized by the Government of Canada and be governed with respect to the matters of construction and telecommunications by the conditions set forth in the relevant conditions included in the exchange of Notes of May 5, 1959, with respect to all other matters.
