- 11:25 a.m. Reception by the Prime Minister and Mrs. Pearson on behalf of the Government of Canada for The Queen and The Duke in the Ballroom of the Chateau Laurier for Members of Parliament, Senators, government officials, certain press representatives and others invited to the number of 1200 people.

- 12:15 p.m. The Royal Couple return to Government House (Ballroom exit).
- 12:40 p.m. The Queen and The Duke arrive at Prime Minister's residence for luncheon.
