The Department of External Affairs announced today that an agreement has been reached between Canada and the Argentine for the avoidance of double taxation on shipping profits.

Under the terms of this Agreement the Argentine
Government undertakes not to tax Canadian concerns on the
profits they earn by operating ships or aircraft to
Argentina. Similarly Canada will exempt from income tax
the revenue received by Argentine ships and aircraft carrying
to and from Canada.

The Agreement is retroactive to January 1, 1946, and covers profits earned since that date.
