DR. HASSO VON ETZDORF, Deputy Representative at the North Atlantic Council

Dr. Hasso Von Etzdorf, a Doctor of Laws, was born at Elbing on March 2, 1900. He entered the German Foreign Service in 1928 and has served in Tokyo, Rome and Palermo. From 1950 to 1953, Dr. Von Etzdorf was attached to the Foreign Office in Bonn. For the past two years, he has been the deputy head of the German delegation in Paris to the committee working toward the realization of the plan for the European Defence Community, now the Western European Union.

With the entry of his country into the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in May 1955,
Dr. Von Etzdorf became the German Deputy Representative at the North Atlantic Council.
