themselves in order to pursue business opportunities in Spain, in the unified market of Europe and in the Spanish-speaking world," Mr. Wilson said.

In addition to being received by the King of Spain, Mr. Wilson is scheduled to meet with his counterpart, the Minister of Industry, Trade and Tourism, as well as with the Secretaries of State for Defence, Industry and Trade, the President of the Spanish Federation of Business Organizations, the Chairman of Banco Central, and other senior Spanish industrialists.

During his visit to Seville, Mr. Wilson and Canadian company representatives supporting Canada's participation in Expo '92 will meet with the Commissioner General of Expo '92, tour the world exposition site and receive dignitaries in the almost completed Canada Pavilion.

"Expo '92, with its theme of discovery, will provide an excellent opportunity to showcase Canadian expertise and leadership in developing new and advanced technologies," Mr. Wilson said.

The business delegation accompanying Mr. Wilson includes Chief Executive Officers (CEOs) and senior executives representing Bombardier Inc., Bristol Aerospace, the Canadian Manufacturers' Association, CAL Corporation, DSMA International Inc., Memotec Data Inc., Northern Telecom, and Spar Aerospace -- all pursuing significant commercial interests in Spain.
