(Note: some staff in the program divisions of geographic branches will be involved in the transfer of the immigration program.)

- transfer of responsibility and accountability is effective April 1
- dates for physical moves are not yet firm, but will be agreed with the recipient organizations
- all EAITC employees are to be offered equivalent positions in recipient organizations
- employees who decline positions in recipient organizations will be eligible for cash-out
- since Canada Council does not operate under the same public service regulations, EAITC employees who do not want to join that organization from the cultural and academic relations program will be offered equivalent public service job or cash-out
- employees who decline both positions in recipient organizations and cash-out will be placed on the Public Service Commission's priority list
- consular affairs and the Passport Office remain at EAITC
