Spirits—

When made from raw grain.....	\$1.50 p. proof gal.
When made from malted barley.....	\$1.52 p. proof gal.
When made from molasses or other sweetened matter.....	\$1.53 p. proof gal.
Malt.....	1½c. p. lb.
Malt liquor, when made in whole or part from any other substance than malt.....	10c. p. gal.
Vinegar.....	6c. p. gal.
Tobacco.....	25c. p. lb.
Cigarettes, weighing not more than 3 lbs. per M....	\$1.50 p. 1,000.
Cigarettes, weighing more than 3 lbs. per M.....	\$6 p. 1,000.
Tobacco, made from Canadian leaf.....	5c. p. lb.
Canada Twist Tobacco.....	5c. p. lb.
Snuff, when containing not more than 40 per cent. of moisture, or when containing over 40 per cent. of moisture and put up in packages of less than 5 lbs. each.....	25c. p. lb.
Snuff, moist, when containing over 40 per cent. of moisture and when in packages of 5 lbs. and over.....	18c. p. lb.
Cigars, from foreign leaf.....	\$6 p. M.
Cigars, from Canadian leaf.....	\$3 p. M.
Cigars, from any leaf, when put up in packages of less than 10 each.....	\$7 p. M.
