



A.—The Cerebrum is the centre of intelligence and thought.

B.—The Cerebellum. This part of the brain controls the action of the voluntary muscles.

C.—The Medulla Oblongata connects the cerebellum with the spinal cord.

D.—The Spinal Cord carries nerve force from the brain to the nerve fibres, whence it is distributed to every nook and corner of the body.

E.—Cauda Equina.

F.—Sciatic Nerve, the derangement of which is known as sciatica and sciatic rheumatism.
