Every animal given has been imported from Great Britain. In 1876 and 1881 the Farm secured several cattle and sheep for Experimental and Educational purposes, but the importation of 1884 exceeds both in variety and value, indeed, when the Dutch or Holstein Cattle and Merino Sheep are obtained, as it is proposed to do in the fall of 1884, there will not be one unrepresented breed of cattle or sheep known as important contributors to the civilized world. The Farm will then be actually in possession of ten breeds of cattle and ten breeds of sheep.

The merit of individuals by pedigree is fully given in this catalogue, but as their value otherwise can only be known by inspection, it may be well to submit some notes on several of the animals.
