The officers of the association are A. H. Clarke, K.C., M.P. of Windsor, president; Frank Arnoldi, K.C., of Toronto; Frank M. Field of Cobourg, and Frank E. Hodgins of Toronto, vice-presidents; W. C. Mikel of Belleville, secretary; Geo. C. Campbell of Toronto, treasurer. There is also an executive council of 15 members, representing every part of the province. Every practising barrister or solicitor in Ontario in good standing, is entitled to membership in the association on payment of the annual fee of one dollar. At the next meeting the constitution and bylaws, as revised and perfected by the executive counand perfected by the executive council, will be presented for discussion and adoption. The president is empowered to call the association together at any time, but it is not an-ticipated that any meeting will be called before the regular meeting in
