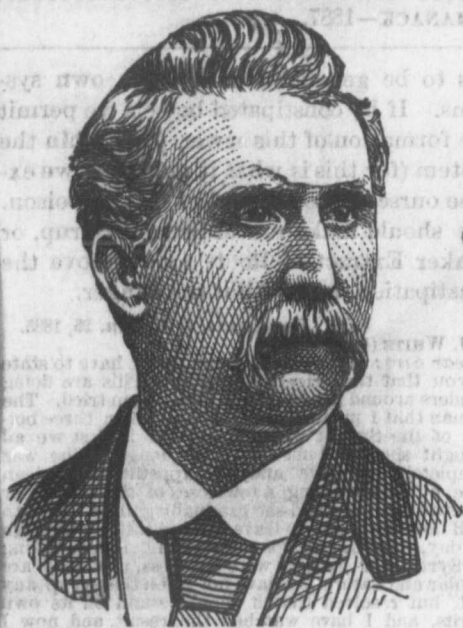




JOHN W. MACKAY.
