Report of the Ladies' Association.

Twelve meetings were held during the months of January, February, March, April, October, November, and December.

The number of ladies attending the meetings of the Association has fallen off somewhat during the past year; the average attendance has been eight, thirteen being the largest number present at any meeting.

The Association has spent the funds entrusted to it in assisting, as far as lay in its power, the really needy of the congregation.

Ten families have been assisted in various ways, by rent, fuel, groceries, clothing etc.. The largest amount given to one family has been \$61.91. In this case the people are old and almost unable to help themselves. The circumstances of those who receive help are well known to the Association, which endeavors to distribute as judiciously as possible the money that is received.
