TO FLY ON A KITE.

"PARACHUTE" BALDWIN'S NEW SCHEME FOR FLOATING ABOVE THE CLOUDS.

8,400 Feet for a Single Jump—During His Trip Around the World, a Basket of Balloons and a Kite.

LONG BEACH, Aug. 1.—Prof. Thomas Baldwin, the pioneer of modern parachute jumping, sat on the West End Hotel piazza last night and briefly reviewed his experiences during his parachute-jumping trip around the world.

"I am afraid," he said, "that the parachute-jumping business has by this time become overdone in England. When I first got there I had the field to myself, and after my opening exhibition I could sell my engagements fast enough to suit the people. I gave eighty-eight descents in all during my trip, and fifty-five of those were made before any competitor appeared on the scene.
