St. Peter's Road, a station on the P. E. I. R., in Queens County.

St. Peters, West, a post settlement in Kings Co., 2 miles from Mount Stewart, contains one store, one saw mill, pop. 275.

Sailor's Hope, a post office in Kings Co., Can. express.

Scotchfort, a post village in Queens Co., on Hillsborough River, 15 miles from Charlottetown, fare 75 cts., contains one store, Can. express, pop. 210.

Sea Cow Head, a post settlement in Prince Co., Can. express, pop. 500.

Sea Cow Pond, a post settlement in Prince Co., Can. express, pop. 300.

Seal River, a small settlement in Queens Co., pop. 20.

Searltown, a post village in Prince Co., 10 miles from Summerside, fare 25 cts., contains one store, Can. express, pop. 275.

Selkirk, in Kings Co., 45 miles from Charlottetown, fare \$1.35, Can. express.

Selkirk Road, a post settlement in Queens Co., contains one store, Can. express, pop. 235.

Shamrock, a post office in Prince Co., Can. express.

Skinner's Pond, a post village in Prince Co., 15 miles from Alberton, fare 75 cts., contains one store, Can. express, pop. 500.

Somerseset, a village in Prince Co., 12 miles from Summerside, fare 50 cts., contains three stores, pop. 275.

Souris, a seaport post and money order town in Kings Co., situated on Souris River, it is 60 miles from Charlottetown by P. E. I. R., fare \$1.80, of which it is the eastern deep-water terminus, contains about twenty-five stores, one post-office and custom-house, one first-class hotel and three others varying in rates, P. E. I. telephone and Anglo-American telegraph, and has two daily mails; the harbor is quite commodious but is an artificial one, formed by a brakewater—the natural harbor, formed by Souris River, being at Souris West and too small to afford refuge to the tonnage frequenting the place.
