Halifax, N. S., Oct. 22.—At two o'clock this afternoon Sheriff Thomas Craig opened court for the purpose of making final declaration of results on the recent provincial election. On the first opening of the court, Friday last, it was found that one ballot box was missing, therefore an adjournment was made to today. All the candidates, in the contest, with the exception of Arthur LeBlanc, leader on the Government ticket, were present.

The proceedings passed off very quietly, nothing occurring to disturb the serenity of the occasion. The only change in the count as previously announced was the discovery of an error in addition, which, being corrected, cuts six votes of the total of David A. Stewart, Opposition, who leads the field.

DEADLOCK IN DOCTOR ISSUE

Some Coal Miners Favor Complete Discontinuation of Present Medical System.

Halifax, N. S., Oct. 22.—It is quite likely that within the next few days some of the U. M. W. locals here will ask the D. C. Co. to discontinue paying the local doctors the customary 25 cents weekly. In the New Brunswick district especially the feeling is strong.
The doctors are at present charging the usual weekly fee but with limitation the miner must pay for operations and medicines. The weekly fee of 25 cents only pays for attendance.
Some of the miners feel that the doctors have not done the right thing in inaugurating a new system without first getting the consent of the men.
The colliery doctor question has reached the stage of a deadlock. Some of the U. M. W. officers are in favor of abolishing the check off and having the colliery doctors revert to private practice. This suggestion has been put forward by some of the doctors themselves.

ONCE MORE THE COMMERCE B'D QUILTS THE JOB

Week's Developments in Regard to Sugar Causes Board to Resign.

HISTORY OF BOARD RATHER CHECKERED

Primary Cause of Latest Upheaval is Gov't's Overruling Sugar Order.

Ottawa, Ont., Oct. 22.—Once more the permanent Board of Commerce has resigned, resulting from this week's developments in regard to the sugar situation. The members of the Board, acting temporarily—Captain W. J. White, Mr. F. A. Achand and Mr. Gerald Dalton—this evening tendered their resignations, which were accepted at an evening council of the Cabinet. The situation is that the authority for the Board—the Act of Parliament—remains, and a new Board may be appointed, but the latest personnel has gone the way of its predecessors. Capt. White remains as secretary—the position he held when appointed acting chairman—and the staff likewise will remain, but that is all for the present. The future is somewhat nebulous, depending to some extent upon the coming judgment of the Privy Council, but the Combines and Fair Prices Act, the base of the Board's activities, can be repealed only by act of Parliament, and it is not likely to be repealed.
Resignations Expected.
The resignations came as the not unexpected climax to the rather stirring scene before the coming judgment of the Privy Council, and they were announced tonight in memorandum from the Premier.
Following the decision of the Government, reversing the order of the Board of Commerce with regard to sugar, the members of the Board tendered their resignation to the Government. No appointments to the vacant positions will now be made. The jurisdiction of the Board will shortly come before the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council for final determination. The Dominion Government has been pressing to have this case decided as soon as possible, but, as the provinces have a right to be heard, it has not yet been possible to have the exact date of the hearing fixed. The decision is given, for as to the extent of the Federal jurisdiction in relation to the Board of Commerce Act it will be for the Government to consider what should then be done.
The correspondence connected with the resignation was not given out with the Premier's statement, but was shortly. Meanwhile, Mr. White declined to make any statement when interviewed.
Checked History.
The history of the Board of Commerce is rather checkered. It was created in August, 1919, and things went fairly well until January, when the chairman, Judge Robson, resigned under circumstances well aired meanwhile. The Commissioner, James Macdougall, resigned, and in doing so made a number of allegations that were denied. Finally, W. F. O'Connor resigned. Before all this had happened the authority of the Board had been questioned, and ultimately there was an appeal to the Supreme Court to determine the constitutionality of the powers exercised. The court was equally divided, and to remove the uncertainty there is an appeal, not yet heard, to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council. Meanwhile, temporarily, a new Board was created, composed of Capt. White, acting chairman; F. A. Achand, Deputy Minister of Labor; and Major Gerald Dalton, purchasing agent of the Department of Justice. These have now resigned.

This will be the first visit made to St. John by Miss Arnold since her election to the important office she now holds. She was made National Vice President at the meeting held in Calgary in June and is proving most efficient and active.
A War Worker
As a war worker Miss Arnold is well known to many St. John ladies for, with Miss Plummer she went over seas before the Federal Order, organizing at Sherbrooke the Canadian Field Comforts Association which did such magnificent service for the boys in the trenches.
The I. O. D. E. in St. John are uniting in giving a hearty welcome to the two visiting officers, and Mrs. Stewart who comes with her as organizing secretary.

TRAWLER THOUGHT LOST ARRIVES AT OVERSEAS PORT

Vessel Reaches Queenstown With Her Engines Disabled But Otherwise All Well.

Halifax, N. S., Oct. 22.—A special cable from London states that the C. D. 37, one of the small fleet of trawlers and drifters, which left Halifax on October 1 for the North of Scotland the Azores, and which was thought to have foundered in mid-Atlantic, has arrived safely at Queenstown, Ireland. The cable stated that it had been feared that C. D. 37 had foundered in a heavy gale in the mid-Atlantic, and there was much surprise when she was towed into Queenstown with her engines disabled. The boat had drifted helplessly for days, during which time she was continually swept by great seas.
When informed this morning of this cable, Captain Munro, who is at H. M. dockyard looking after the boats being sent to Scotland, said that C. D. 37 had left here early in October in company with two trawlers and two other drifters. These were the last drifters to sail, owing to the lateness of the season, and that now only trawlers would be sent across the Atlantic. Four of these crafts are expected to leave Halifax tomorrow morning.

SOLDIERS AND POLICE KILLED BY SINN FEIN

Fatalities Reported from Four Places in Fighting and Raids During Last Day.

Dublin, Oct. 22.—Two policemen were killed today when with four of their colleagues they were attacked from ambush by fifty disguised men at Feakle, County Clare.
Attain, County Wick.
Dublin, Oct. 22.—A group of nineteen policemen were ambushed at Parkwood, King's County today. The driver of one of the police cars was shot dead and one constable was wounded. A member of the attacking party was seen to fall during the exchange of shots.
Military Lorries Raided.
Dublin, Oct. 22.—Three military lorries today were subjected to a twenty-five minute attack at West Mullingar. Several policemen are believed to have been wounded.
Exploded a Bomb.
Cork, Oct. 22.—One of the five soldiers wounded this morning when two military lorries were ambushed fourteen miles from Cork, died this evening. According to A. H. Roberts, whose farm faces the road where the ambush was laid, the attacking party exploded a mine in the roadway by an electric current from a pit dug at the roadside. The leading lorry barely escaped the explosion, while the second lorry ran squarely into the mine made by it. In the explosion a police officer and one soldier were instantly killed.

SHOT IN THIGH.

Harold, a ten-year-old boy, who resides out in the Loch Lomond district, was admitted to the General Hospital yesterday afternoon with a severe wound in his thigh, caused by the accidental discharge of a shotgun. The wound was dressed and the young fellow was reported early this morning as doing as well as could be expected, and no serious results are expected.
