

### Fees and Current Expenses.

1. A fee of one dollar is charged for registration, and an additional fee of one dollar for matriculation. The fee for an Honor Certificate is one dollar, for the Degree of B. A., five dollars; for the Degree of M. A., ten dollars. The fees for Honor Certificates and Degrees must be paid before the Annual Meeting of the Senate. If a student is excused from a regular Examination, he may have a special Examination, for which a fee of two dollars for each subject will be charged.

2. Board and rooms for about 60 students are provided in Chipman Hall. The charge for board, which includes washing, room-rent and fuel—everything except light—ranges from \$2.75 to \$3.50, according to room. Board and lodgings can be obtained in approved places in the town at reasonable rates.

3. The following are the College charges :

Students shall pay to the Treasurer, or secure to the satisfaction of the Executive Committee, all tuition fees, board bills, room-rent and other bills due to the University on or before the following dates :—For the Fall Term, December 5th, and for the Winter Term, April 5th, in each College Year. Students failing to comply with this rule shall be excluded from class exercises and examinations after the dates named.
