WIDDIFIELD, J. HENRY, *M.D., M.R.C.S. (Eng.); L.R.C.P. (Eng.) (North York.)*

Family came originally from Eng. S. of the late Charles Ellis Widdifield, Esq., of Maple Grove Farm, Whitchurch, Ont., and grands. of the late Henry Widdifield, a U.E. Loyalist, who came to Whitchurch, 1801, and was one of the earliest settlers of North York. B. at Maple Grove Farm, Whitchurch, 12 June, 1812. Ed. at Newmarket High Sch. and Victoria Univ. Unmarried. Studied for his profession at Victoria Medical Coll., Toronto, and at St. Thomas' Hospital, Medical and Surgical Coll., London, Eng. Is a graduate in Medicine and Surgery of the Royal Coll. of Surgeons of Eng., the Royal Coll. of Physicians of Edin., Victoria Univ., Can., and the Coll. of Physicians and Surgeons of Ont. Has been a Coroner for York, and is now a J.P. for the same Co. Holds first-class certificates from the Toronto School of Military Instruction and the Toronto School of Gunnery. Has been for many years an active mem. of the Masonic Order. Is a Past Dist. Deputy Grand Master of the Toronto Dist., and a mem. of the Board of General Purposes, also Grand representative of the Grand Lodge of Iowa in the Grand Lodge of Can. Has been for six years Provincial Medical Examiner for the Grand Lodge of Ontario. Received the Reform nomination for the Commons in 1874, but declined it, and again in 1882. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g.e. 1875; re-elected at g.e. 1879, 1883 and 1886. Moved the Address in reply to the Speech from the Throne at the session of 1875. Held the position of Ministerial Whip under the Mowat Govt. from 1877 to 1883, when he resigned. Has been Chairman of the Committee on Standing Orders in the Assem.
