

An Act to explain and amend the Clergy Reserves Appropriation Amendment Act of 1856, as regards the mode of ascertaining the number of Rate-payers in the several Municipalities in Upper Canada.

FOR the removal of doubts under the enactment hereinafter mentioned : Her Majesty &c., enacts as follows : Preamble.

The word "Ratepayers" in the first and second sections of the Act passed in the Session held in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Act to amend the Provincial Act appropriating the moneys arising from the Clergy Reserves*, shall be held and taken to mean those persons and those only who shall be residents within the limits of the Municipalities mentioned in the said Acts, and whose names shall appear on the Assessment Rolls of each Municipality as Rate-payers:—And the affidavit to be made and returned to the Receiver General's Office by the clerks of the several Municipalities, under the second section of the said Act shall be made in the form of the schedule to this Act annexed. A. B.
