An Act to explain and amend the Clergy Reserves Appropriation Amendment Act of 1856, as regards the mode of ascertaining the number of Rate-payers in the several Municipalities in Upper Canada.

OR the removal of doubts under the enactment hereinafter mention- Preamble. ed: Her Majesty &c., enacts as follows:

The word "Ratepayers" in the first and second sections of the Act Word "Ratepassed in the Session held in the nincteenth and twentieth years of Her payers" in 19 5 Majesty's Reign, and intituled, An Act to amend the Provincial Act how to be appropriating the moneys arising from the Clergy Reserves, shall be construed held and taken to mean those persons and those only who shall be residents within the limits of the Municipalities mentioned in the said Acts, and whose names shall appear on the Assessment Rolls of each Muni-10 cipality as Rate-payers:—And the affidavit to be made and returned to Form of affidathe Receiver General's Office by the clerks of the several Municipalities, vit under said under the second section of the said Act shall be made in the form of the Act. schedule to this Act annexed.
