added: "Unless the fence then in question has been carried away by water, or destroyed by fire, or by any other unforescen accident; in which case the special notice above mentioned need only be given fifteen days before the complaint."

PENALTIES.

"Every person obliged by proces-verbal to contribute to the works in and about a water-course, in the proportion of the extent of land drained thereby, who refuses or neglects to declare to the inspector or trustee who requires him to do so, what extent of his land is drained by such water-course, shall incur a penalty of not less than four nor 10more than cight dollars."

APPEALS.

Appeals may 6. Appeals from judgments rendered in virtue of the Agricultural be proceeded. Act, and of the Act, amending it, may be proceeded with as well in vacation as in term.

INTERPRETATION.

Addition to 7. After the word "stream," in the second paragraph of the fortysection 45 of fifth section of the first cited Act, the words "gully, or natural watersaid Act. course," shall be added.
