

Administration blasted in rally at Laurentian

SUDBURY (CUP)—Over 1,200 of Laurentian University's 1,800 students joined faculty members Monday (Oct. 20) to criticize their university administration and look at possible reforms.

The largest mass meeting in Laurentian's history was precipitated by a visit from the Ontario Commission on University Affairs, which is preparing a five-year plan for Ontario universities.

Students and faculty had been told of the commission's visit only one week earlier, yet were expected to prepare briefs within that time limit.

On Thursday (Oct. 16) students also discovered that administration president Stanley Mullins had a fully-prepared brief ready to be approved by a secret meeting of the academic senate.

When student senators showed up for the meeting it was cancelled.

After listening to Mullins' brief at the commission's Monday meeting, and having their own briefs calling for local reorganization ignored because the commission said it didn't want to get involved in local questions, the students and many faculty members moved to their own meeting.

The mass meeting gave particular attention to the recommendations of the University of Toronto's Commission on University Government.

The CUG report, released Thursday (Oct. 16) calls for abolition of the Board of Governors and other structural changes involving increased student participation in university government.
