Thank you for a most empathy-provoking Arts Supplement (Volume 120 Number 12, The Gazette). It is difficult to

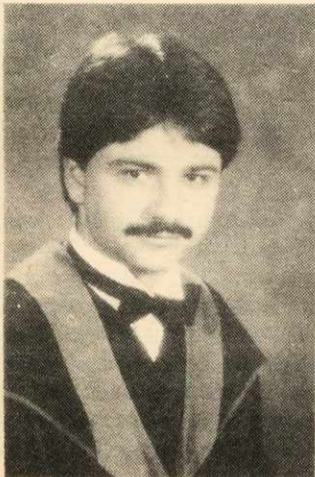
fault any of the writing or illustrations in any way, which surprises me greatly, although perhaps it should not.

The Department of Biochemistry of the University of Alberta (20 academic staff members) is recruiting candidates for admission to graduate studies. Areas of investigation include the following: structure and function of enzymes and other proteins, including the application of x-ray crystallography and high field nuclear magnetic resonance; molecular biology; membrane biology; cell surface receptor function, molecular virology; DNA structure, replication and interaction with proteins; biochemistry and molecular genetics of immune responses; metabolic control mechanisms; lipid and lipoprotein metabolism; molecular biology of bacterial surface structures. 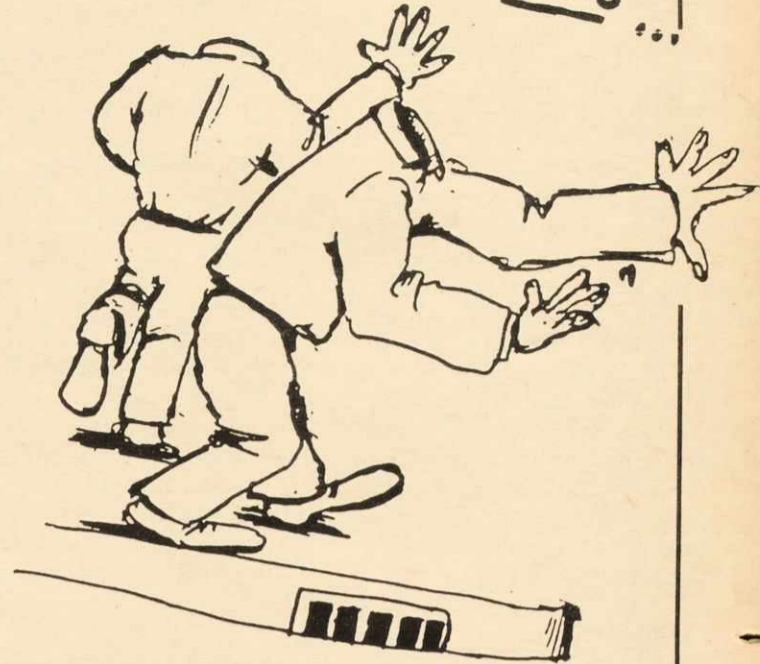
