"It is not at all clear why Leon Perelman should be seeking re-entry to Canada so long after the war if all the time he intended to return. We are aware that his return during the war was impossible, but it was not impossible for this man to return to Canada at any time within the past two years. I doubt very much whether we can recognize his retention of Canadian domicile in view of the time that has elapsed since return was possible.
