Dear Sir,

I am directed by the Right Honourable Arthur Meighen to advise you that the Soldier Settlement Board has today advised him that they understand you have a returned soldier who wants to buy your farm, and that if your place is taken over by another settler an attestation certificate may be given you for the purpose of making a soldier grant entry. The Board further inform Mr. Meighen that if any indebtedness remains it will be chargeable against the land for which you may enter as soldier grant, and that the District Superintendent at Winnipeg has been so advised. Mr. Meighen asks me to say he trusts the matter may work out to your satisfaction.
