I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, relative to the desire of Alfred McCue to receive a loan of \$100.00 from band funds; and in reply I beg to say that the Department does not sanction loans being made to parties who have their lands leased. If McCue can make arrangements to have the improvements made by persons willing to undertake consider the same the Department will the arrangements and will, if he gives orders against his rent money for payment for the said improvements, accept the same , and make payment when the rent moneys are received.
