Sir,


I beg to refer you to Departmental letter of the 16th May, 1917, with respect to the will of the late Lucy E. Isaac, which was written to the late Mr. Charles McGibbon. It does not appear that we have ever had a reply to that letter.

Mr. W.M. Charlton, of Brantford, has written in on behalf of Mrs. Susan Summerhayes, and I am enclosing herein copy of his letter. I beg to refer you also to Minute of Council, No. 22, of the 12th June, 1917, as follows: "The Council decided not to entertain the case of Mrs. Susan Summerhayes relative to her late mother's estate as the matter has already been disposed of by the Chiefs."

It does not appear what disposition the Chiefs had previously made of this matter. Would you be good enough to look into the circumstances of this estate and advise the Department?
