Great Convention of 1919 first stage in re-building of a united, broad nation-wide party.

Gradual return of Liberal Unionists.

Growing rapprochement with vast majority of Progressives.

Process largely completed in election of 1926 - result a handsome Liberal majority from 1926 to 1930.

Electoral Reverse of 1930 - a blessing in disguise - gave country a clear taste of the folly of extreme Tory policies as contrasted with sound and moderate Liberal policies of preceding period.

Overwhelming Liberal trumph of 1935 with greatest majority of any government up to that time.
