11-43054 Sgt Frankowski J., sworn states claim N-43054 Sgt Frankowski J and at present claim Pl. Sgt of 1st Pl. "B" Coy 1st Wpgr Rifles. On the 7 Nov 44 I was holding the same position I recognize Rfr. Russell, he present as the accused & he has been in my pl. since the latter part of July. On Nov 6 44 we were still in the tent and the ~~Sgt~~ CSM that night at meal parade warned all the Pl. Sgts to see that all big packs were ready in the morning and to have the men ready to move off sometime the next day, Nov 7/44. The ^{by myself at approx 1700 hrs} see Orders were warned that the regular morning parade was cancelled. On the morning of the 7 Nov 44 they were warned again to see that the packs were there at 1000 hrs. & to have the men ready to move off at 1300 hrs. At approx 1000 hrs 7 Nov 44 Sgt Goodall, now T/Sgt Goodall, came to me & reported that he could not find Russell.
