The Order of Morning Prayer.

The Service shall be the same with the usual office for Holydays, except where it is in this Office otherwise appointed.

¶ Let him that ministereth read with an audible voice these sentences of Scripture; and after them the Exhortation—Dearly beloved Brethren, &c.

TO the Lord our God belong mercies and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against him; neither have obeyed the voice of the Lord our God, to walk in his laws, which he set before us.

In my trouble I will call upon the Lord, and complain unto my God. So fhall he hear my voice out of his holy temple.

¶ Proper Pfalms, LI, LVI, LXXIII. ¶ First Leffon, lfaiah X. verfe 5—19, both inclusive. ¶ After the first Leffon shall follow—Te Deum laudamus.

¶ Second Lesson, Matth. III. 1-12.

Then the Benedictus, the Creed, &c. to the end of the Lord's Prayer.

¶ I ben the Priest, standing up, shall fay,
