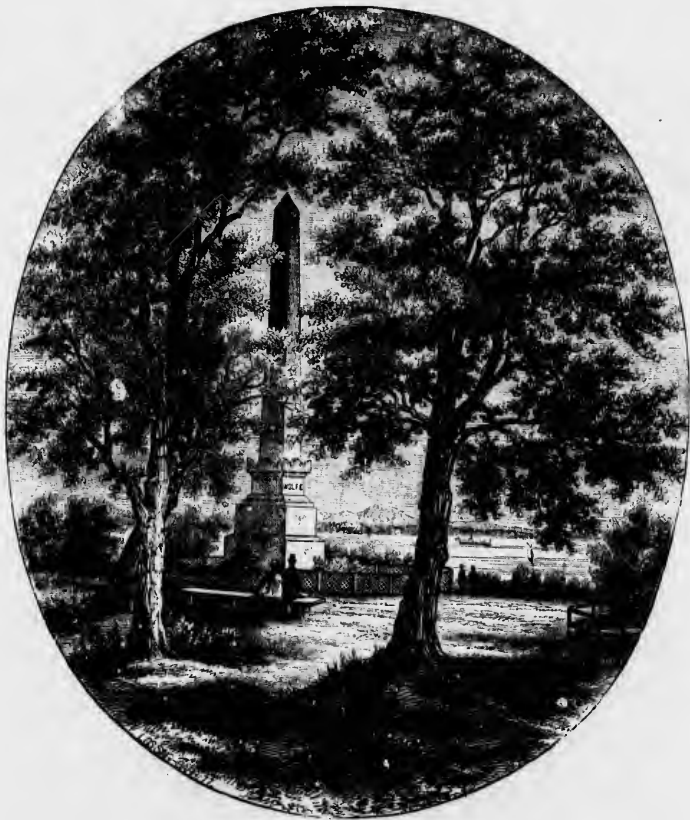




WOLFE AND MONTCALM'S MONUMENT.

from the pencil of Captain Young, 79th Highlanders, and the concise but eloquent inscription is by Dr. J. C. Fisher, at one time connected with the Quebec press, for which inscription he was awarded a gold medal. It reads as follows:

WOLFE—MONTCALM.
MORTEM VIRTUS COMMUNEM;
FAMAM HISTORIA;
MONUMENTUM POSTERITAS.
DEDIT.
A. D. 1827.

Which, being rendered into English, means: "Military virtue gave them a common death history a common fame; posterity a common monument."

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
