Letters posted in Canada addressed to any place within the Province pass, if prepaid, for 5 cents per ½ oz., but if posted unpaid, such letters are charged 7 cents per ½ oz. On Letters to Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward's Island, the rates is 5

cents per ½ oz., with optional prepayment. The rate on Letters to the United Kingdom is, by Canadian Packet,

MAILS FOR CANADA FROM ENGLAND.

Two Ocean Steamers carrying mails for Canada leave Liverpool in each week, viz.: a Canadian Packet on every Thursday, via Derry on Friday, sailing to Quebec in summer and Portland in winter, by which the Postage Rate is 6d. stg. per ½ oz.; and a Cunard Packet every Saturday, via Cork on Sunday, bringing mails for Canada, alternately to Boston and New York, by which the Postage Rate to Canada is 8d. sterling per 1 oz.

The British Post Office forwards letters to Canada by the first packet sailing after the letter is posted, unless the letters bear a special direction, "By Canadian Packet," or "By British Packet," and in that case they are kept over for the packet designated. "By Canadian Mail" is not a distinctive superscription, for any mail for Canada is a "Canadian Mail," by whatever packet forwarded.

REGISTRATION OF LETTERS.

Persons posting Letters containing value, should be careful to require them to be registered, and to obtain from the Postmaster a Certificate of Receipt for Registration.
