Conditions under which the Competition for the Silver Medals presented by His Excellency the Governor General to the Provincial Rijle Association of the Province of...., are to be carried out for the year 1879.

1. The Competitors to be members of the Association receiving the Medals and effective members of the Active Militia of the Dominion.

2. The highest aggregate scores in three competitions at 500 and 600 yards to win the Silver Medal and second highest aggregate at the same ranges to win the Bronze Medal.

3. The scores to be made with seven rounds at each Range, fired in any position with Snider Enfield Rifles, Government pattern, and may be fired as part of any of the matches in the annuel competition of the Association.

4. If there are not three competitions in which the Ranges above mentioned are used, then one or more special competitions may be held for the purpose of deciding the winners of the Medals, and such special competitions shall be open to all qualified competitors who have competed at the previous matches.

5. The Secretary of the Provincial Association receiving the Medals shall forward to the Secretary of the Dominion Rifle Association a record of the scores made in the competitions for these medals.
