Missionary Items

A new Bishop for Japan.

Dr. Awdry, Bishop of Southampton, has been appointed to the Bishopric of Osaka. The S. P. G. provides the salary of the Bishop, and the appointment is left entirely in the hands of the Primate.



One of the world's wonders in the triumphs of Modern Mission is that of the Church Missionary Society in Uganda, Africa. When Stanley visited there 18 years ago, there were no missionaries. He sent home word of the open field. Laborers went out; persecution followed. The names of the devoted Bishop Hannington, and Mackay, and of the cruel Mtesa, figure in the story. But now there are besides the foreign Missionaries, 130 native Evangelists, supported by the native church, and laboring at 85 different stations. There are 200 buildings for public worship and teaching, and in there there gathered on Sunday 20,000 worshippers. More than 800 adult converts were baptized during the past year.



Noon-day Prayer for Missions

The Church of England Missionary Conference, held in London in May, 1894, adopted the custom of noon-day prayer upon suggestion from the American Church, and in their report said: "The conference is now among the things of the past. Is it too much to hope that at least one permanent memorial of it may remain amongst us, and that from many of our churches the noonday bell may call us, in the field, the workshop, or the mart, to lift our hearts, at any rate for a moment, in prayer for all the missions of the Church of Christ?"
