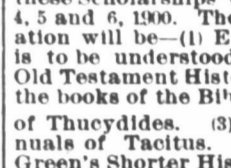

**Church of England in Canada**

Three Scholarships, each of a value equivalent to the fees for the College year (tuition and residence) and twenty pounds in addition, and tenable for the two years of the College course, are offered by the **Diocesan Theological College of Montreal, Canada**, for public competition to graduates in Arts in any recognized University, who are about to prepare for the Ministry of the Church, but have not already begun their course of Divinity in any Theological College or University.  
The Examination for these Scholarships will be held on September 4, 5 and 6, 1900. The subjects of the Examination will be—(1) ENGLISH BIBLE. By this is to be understood a general knowledge of Old Testament History, and of the contents of the books of the Bible. (2) GREEK. 7th Book of Thucydides. (3) LATIN. 18th Book Annals of Tacitus. (4) ENGLISH HISTORY. Green's Shorter History of the English People, from the Norman Conquest to the Restoration. (5) ROMAN HISTORY. The general facts of Roman History from the death of Sulla to the death of Constantine (as outlined for instance in Merivale's General History of Rome). (6) CHURCH CATECHISM. The text, with "The Church Catechism Explained," by the Rev. A. W. Robinson (Camb. Univ. Press.) Each candidate must first make application for admission to the College and have his application accepted. Applications for admission to the College, and to the above examination must be made on or before May 15th, 1900, to **REV. MAURICE DAY, M. A., No. 17 Earlsfort Terrace, Dublin, Ireland**, from whom copies of the College Calendar, as well as all necessary papers and all further information can be obtained.
