BY HIS EXCELLENCY

Sir JOHN WENTWORTH, Baronet, L. L. D.

Lieutenant-Governor, and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of NOVA-SCOTIA, and its Dependencies, &c. &c. &c.

WHEREAS the *General Assembly*, of this Province stands prorogued unto Thursday, the Twelfth Day of April next.

I HAVE therefore thought fit, further to Prorogue the said *General Assembly*, unto Friday, the Eighth Day of June next, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business; of which all Persons concerned are hereby required to take Notice, and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand, and Seal at Arms, at Halifax, this 13th Day of March, 1798, in the 38th year of His Majesty's Reign.
