—The death occurred in St. Thomas on Friday of Mr. William P. Orr, youngest son of the late James Orr, North street, after a lingering illness of some two years. The deceased is survived by a wife and two little daughters, aged seven and nine, to mourn his loss; also three brothers and two sisters, Mrs. S. J. Bell and Mrs. John Sures, of London; Oscar F., in the Northwest; James E., of North street, and John Sures, of London. The funeral was held yesterday from the residence of his brother, Mr. James E. Orr, to Hunt's Cemetery.

WILL DRAG FOR BODY.
There is a considerable amount of ice in the river near Woodland Cemetery, and it is thought that the body of the late Duncan MacMartin may be near that place. If, possible, the friends will drag the river in the vicinity in an effort to locate the body.

DATE FIXED EARLY.
The East Middlesex Farmers' Institute has decided to run an excursion to the Ontario Agricultural College, Guelph, on June 27. This will be a very popular outing for either pleasure or profit.

THE LATE ADAM MCGILL.
Mr. Adam McGill, who died yesterday at Victoria Hospital as a result of injuries received by a fall, had many friends in London, says the correspondent of the Woodstock Sentinel-Review, for he had lived there up till about ten years ago, carrying on his trade as a carpenter. He was a well-known figure in the town and was universally respected in London. His wife, formerly Miss Bishop, of London, died in 1891, and he leaves one daughter, Mary, a nurse in Victoria Hospital. His brother, Patrick McGill, of St. Catharines, is making the funeral arrangements.

AN INCORRIBLE GIRL.
The monthly meeting of the Children's Aid Society held yesterday afternoon, did not conclude the business before it, and another meeting will be held next Monday, when the insector's report will be disposed of. The afternoon was spent in discussing the case of a young girl who was incorrigible. The child had been sent back from several homes. It is not used for the board to deal with cases of this kind, but in this instance it was thought best to rely upon the generosity of friends of the society in London, and arrange for the keeping of the child in the Industrial School at Toronto for a time.

DEATH OF MRS. GRANGER.
Mrs. Susan Mason Granger, widow of Edward Granger, died yesterday at her home, 389 Dufferin avenue, after a very lengthy illness. Seventy-four years ago she married the late John Granger, coming to London in 1847. She married Edward Granger in 1850, and they moved to con. 13, of London Township, where they resided until Mr. Granger retired from active life. Mrs. Granger was a devoted member of the Church of England. Two sons, James and George, of this city; one daughter, Mrs. O. H. Talbot, and three brothers and one sister survive her. The funeral will be held on Wednesday to Woodland Cemetery.

A LONDONER'S ABILITY.
Referring to Elder Evans, of this city, the Cleveland Leader says: "The parliamentary knowledge of the two young members of the first presidency of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, Frederick M. Smith, first president, and Richard C. Evans, second, counselor to the president, was thoroughly tested at the conferences in Kirtland, Ohio, during the sessions over which the late president presided. Both have acquitted themselves with credit and mistakes in ruling having been few. Once or twice each case decision have been questioned and members of the general body have appealed from the decision of the president, but it has not been overruled in any instance."

MUST GUARANTEE SALARY.
The Anglican Bishop of Toronto has decided that for the future before appointing any clergyman to any incumbency in his diocese a guarantee as to salary must be given by the people. The form of guarantee is as follows: "Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned members of the congregation of St. Basil's Church, in the town of Toronto, hereby guarantee and agree to the one with the other of us, and with the Reverend Brown Jones Robinson, the incumbent of the said church, that he shall receive a salary for the period of five years from the date hereof, to be paid by the churchwardens of the said church at the rate of \$1,500 per annum, payable in monthly installments, the first of such installments to be paid on the day of 1904. (Note.—This must be signed by at least a majority of the heads of families in the congregation. As a matter of course the names here used are fictitious.) So far, no such rule has been put into force by the Bishop of Toronto, but there is a probability that he will do so in the near future."
