

Allow twenty minutes for each quarter of a pound.

DELICATE INDIAN PUDDING. -One quart of milk scalded, two heaping table pounfuls of meal; cook twelve minutes; stir into this one tablespoonful of butter, then beat three eggs with four tablespoonfuls of sugar, one-half tablespoonful of ginger, salt to taste, mix all thoroughly, and bake one hour.

LEMON FOAM.—Beat well together the yolks of six eggs, half a pound of powdered sugar, two grated lemons, half-ounce of gelatine dissolved in cold water. Summer over the fire until quite thick. Beat the whites of the eggs to a stiff froth, add them to the mixture; beat together and pour into moulds.

Then cover the place with a dry cloth, and let it remain so for a day.


