

that lumber promises to be a good article for investment for several years to come. No sales are in contemplation and it can safely be asserted that the recent period of activity in limit transfers will be followed by one of calm.

Recent reports from the limits go to show that good progress is being made in the preparation of logs for next year's sawing. Natural conditions have so far been favorable, and the operators are looking forward to an open Fall. The scarcity of labor, however, is complained of in every quarter and it is now pretty well assured that this shortage will have a corresponding effect on the output of logs. The fact that several firms have resumed operations after a rest of years' duration, has placed an extra demand on the local labor market which it is impossible to satisfy. The natural result—men of all classes, and boys for that matter, are being engaged this season, who a few years ago would not have stood one chance in twenty of getting employment. No report of disease in the camps has been received so far, and the operators feel confident that vigilance will go a long way towards preventing a repetition of last year's costly experience, when small-pox broke up whole lumber camps.

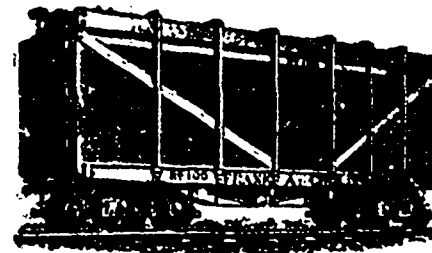
