CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

We must confess to some disappointment with the volume of the lumber demand. Up to the present time the activity which was predicted a month or six weeks ago has not materialized, and midsummer is not usually the time when there is an expansion in business. While the consumption of lumber is moderately active, there is a pronounced disposition on the part of buyers to pursue a conservative policy. Two gentlemen with whom the writer conversed expressed similar views, namely, that they porposed reducing their stocks and would purchase only for requirements. With this attitude so well defined, it is unreasonable to expect much
